## **Browser Versions**

MIEMSS Online Training Center will operate using the browsers listed below, but typically runs best in the latest versions.

- Firefox
- Safari 6 for Mac
- Internet Explorer 9 or later Note: IE 10 required for drag and drop of files from outside the browser
  into Moodle. If you are experiencing problems with IE and the Online Training Center please try setting the
  Compatibility View settings to include miemss.org
- Chrome: Occasionally, users may have difficulty viewing embedded video segments when using certain
  versions of Google Chrome. If you experience this problem, use either Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox web
  browsers to view course content.

\*\*You may find it helpful to have more than one browser installed on your computer. If you run into problems using Moodle, moving to another browser may resolve your issues.

## Required Browser Settings

The following browser settings should be selected:

- Enable Cookies
- Enable Javascript
- Do not block pop-up windows

Note: In some browsers, you can make an exception for MIEMSS Online Training Center(aka Moodle) if you don't want to use these settings for all websites.
